

Woods Grading Policy:

Students at the elementary level must demonstrate academic mastery by maintaining a passing average in math, language arts, and either science or social studies. Therefore, grades reported at Woods Intermediate will reflect the student's independent mastery level of academic concepts and not grades obtained through guided practice.

Core Content Area Grades:

There will be a minimum of 6 grades recorded per core subject area each six weeks.

Numerical grades will be given in all core subject areas.

No weighted grades will be given in Reading, Math, English, or Social Studies.

Weighted grades in Science will be 50% Daily/Homework Grades and 50% Science Labs

Incomplete Grades:

If grades are incomplete at the end of the grading period the teacher will record an "I" for incomplete on the report card. It is the responsibility of the student to see that all work is made up within a six-week period. Teachers may provide students a "time extension" for extenuating circumstances. If the work is not made up within the time allowed, the grade will automatically become a "50" and be recorded.

Late Work/ Missing Assignments:

Students will be held accountable for work class work and homework not completed. Teachers may deduct points for lateness. However, the best consequence for failing to turn in work is to have to do the work anyway; therefore, students will still be expected to complete missing assignments regardless of point deductions. Teachers may employ disciplinary consequences when Late Work or Missing Assignments become habitual.
